HISTORY

All items were stored together, the letter from 1897 has a "Beloit Historical Society" stamp, but they might not all be from the same donation. It is not listed under any people whose names are on the items.

The congregation was founded April 24, 1841 by Rev. Alvah Burgess. The current building at 617 Public Avenue, Beloit, WI was built in January, 1928. (from the church website)

The congregation is still active as of 2024.

Scope of Collection

The bulk of the collection consists of weekly bulletins from 1914-1949. Most are from the 1940s. Also includes one letter from 1897, one mailing from the 40s, and a few undated items.
