FOUNDER HISTORY

The American War Mothers was founded in 1917 by Alice M. and given a Congressional Charter on February 24, 1925. It is headquartered in Washington, D.C. and is a perpetual patriotic, non-profit, non political, non-sectarian, non-partisan organization whose members are mothers of children who have served or are serving in the Armed Services during times of conflict. It now falls under the Department of Veterans Affairs. The mothers visit wounded soldiers in hospitals, assemble shaving kits, consul mothers of deployed troops, and perform other missions.

This is a small collection of items, pamphlets, song lyrics, newspaper clippings, an open letter from the National President and Founder, Gretta Roush, and scrapbooks.
