## **HISTORY**

Mason H. Dobson (1891-1952) was an editor, column writer and co-owner of the Beloit Daily News. (Not to be confused with his son, Mason C. Dobson, Beloit Daily News reporter) He worked there in 1913-1949. "Dobson was a deputy director of civilian war relief for the Red Cross in the Mediterranean theater during World War II" (According to his obituary) Dobson was inducted into the Beloit Historical Hall of Fame in 1978.

## **Scope of Collection**

A collection of files from Mason H. Dobson, from his work at the Beloit Daily News. The files are kept under the names given by Dobson, but the physical folders have been replaced with non acidic archival folders. One original folder has been preserved as its own item ('editorials' the last folder in Box 3). The folders were not in any clear order when they arrived, so they have been placed in alphabetical order by title. The one exception is the two files labeled " "Colored People" and "Human Rights" which contain similar material about African Americans in Beloit. The two folders have been left as received, and placed together under 'Equal Rights /Civil Rights Issues'.
