HISTORY

"Lyn (Eleanor Marilyn) Vodak Larkin (1916-1996) was born in Hillsboro Wisconsin. in 1925 her family moved to Beloit, where she attended Beloit public schools and college. After employment in the office of the 'Beloit Daily News', she was office manager for the San Francisco headquarters of the 'Beverage Industry News' from 1939 to 1946. On December 12, 1941, Lyn married Francis J. Larkin, patent attorney in San Francisco where they lived until 1948. Her husband's work took them to Ohio and then to the Chicago area for twenty-five years. The Larkins retired to Leisure World, Laguna Hills, California, for five years before returning to Beloit in 1979. Mrs. Larkin was widowed in 1982. Some of her published articles and poetry have been catalogued and shelved by the Koret Living Library of the Fromm Institute in the Gleeson Library, University of San Francisco." "She died in 1996 after a long illness." From a bio included in the collection. She writes extensively about her life, Czech heritage, and gardening.

Scope of Collection

This collection contains both personal papers and writings by Larkin.

Her writings include published and draft short stories, most of an unpublished memoir, as well as poetry. Personal papers include loose papers, as well as scrapbooks with personal and family photos, genealogy, newspaper clippings and realia such as school pins and ribbons.
