FINDING AID

HISTORY

The Fortnightly was the oldest study group for women in Beloit. It was organized on October 3, 1892, by a group of women living within a two block area between Bushell and Chapin Streets and Wisconsin and Park Avenues to study the countries exhibiting at the Columbian Exposition of 1893 in Chicago. From the beginning there was a warm, friendly feeling among the members. Printed programs from 1894 to the present reflect the dedication of the members to the object of the organization stated in the Constitution adopted in 1894. Programs for the first 15 years centered on one country. It has engaged in community welfare services and in philanthropic and patriotic activities, especially World Wars I and II. Fortnightly was a charter member of the Beloit Federation of Women in 1894, and retained its membership until 1951.

SCOPE OF COLLECTION

The activities of The Fortnightly Club are well documented through the Secretary's Meeting Minutes Books covering the years 1892-1993, and the Yearbooks representing the activities and programs, from the Club's inception in 1892-2006. In addition, the Historian's Scrapbook and reports highlight the history and accomplishments of the Club and its members. Supportive correspondence, tributes and annual reports of the President round out the collection.
